ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

During the second semester of the sophomore year students must contact their advisor to initiate admission to one of the AACSB accredited business programs. Students seeking admission to upper-division courses who have not completed all of the required pre-admission course work will be allowed to pre-register for upper-division courses if they satisfy the minimum grade point average requirements at the time of application and if they are concurrently enrolled in the courses necessary to complete the pre-admission requirements. Failure to meet all requirements for admission will result in denial of admission to the college; students denied admission will not be admitted to upper-division classes. Students may appeal to an appeals committee.

The admission standards are as follows:

1) Applicant must have completed the following pre-admission courses with a combined **GPA of 2.25**:

- ACC 200 and ACC 201
- BPA 215
- CIS 243 (with a minimum grade of C)
- CIV 201 or CIV 202
- COM 161
- CSC 199
- ECO 230 and ECO 231
- ENG 105 (with a minimum grade of C)
- HUM 211
- MAT 140
- MAT 220

(2) Applicant must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0.

Other Requirements

- [] 2.0 GPA in courses taken at Murray State University.
- [] 2.0 GPA in area, major/minor taken at Murray State University.
- [] Includes at least 32 semester hours at Murray State University.
- [] Includes at least 20 of the last 32 semester hours in residence at Murray State University.
- [] Includes minimum of 120 unduplicated semester hours earned in courses numbered 100 or above.
- [] Includes 42 upper-level hours.
- [] 2.0 GPA overall.
- [] 2.00 GPA in 300 level and above ACC courses.
