## What is a Peer Career Advisor?

A Peer Career Advisor is a trained Career Services paraprofessional who commits five (5) hours a week to assist with outreach and career events as well as advise students in job search strategies through one-on-one interactions and group presentations for the 2014/2015 academic year.

- Understand significance Career Services plays in the lives of MSU students
- Able to train during April 2014
- Able to serve 5 hours a week, fall 2014 and spring 2015 semesters when class is in session
