◆ Important Notes for MCU Students◆:

- (1) You will be allowed to transfer up to six (6) of your MCU Graduate Courses to MSU: that is, 18 Credit Hours
- (2) Where appropriate, you will be required to take those foundation courses needed for you to succeed in the rest of your twelve (12) hours of the 30-credit hour MBA Program at Murray State University. So, for instance, if you only have one Accounting course at the undergraduate level (such as Managerial Accounting), you will be required to take MSU's ACC 200 (Financial Accounting) before taking the graduate level ACC 604.
- (3) For this group of Mid Continent University students only, the GMAT/GRE has been waived. No, you do not need to take the GRE/GMAT if you are part of the affected MCU students.
- (4) ACC 604, ECO 625, FIN 602 and MKT 667 would be the remaining core courses for students transferring 18 Hours.
