NOTES:

Music majors may substitute MUS 172 and MUS 175. Piano Class I and II are offered in the fall and spring semesters, respectively. These courses should be taken back to back.
- Voice Class I and II are offered in the fall and spring semesters, respectively. These courses should be taken back to back. Music majors may substitute MUS 119 (two semesters) for this requirement.

At least six hours in the Music Minor must be upper level courses.
