## Family Nurse Practitioner

The Family Nurse Practitioner is an advanced practice nurse who provides primary health care services to all members of the family. Emphasis is placed on health promotion and preventive care across the lifespan. The FNP is prepared to manage a wide range of acute and chronic health problems in a variety of settings.

The curriculum prepares the student to write the Family Nurse Practitioner ANCC certification exam.

**Prerequisites:** anatomy, physiology, chemistry, nursing assessment, nursing research, statistics (descriptive and inferential)
