Refund Policy

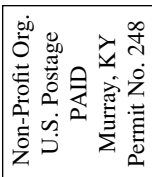
Except for a \$15 processing fee, the program fee is refundable if we receive written notice of cancellation by June 2, 2009.

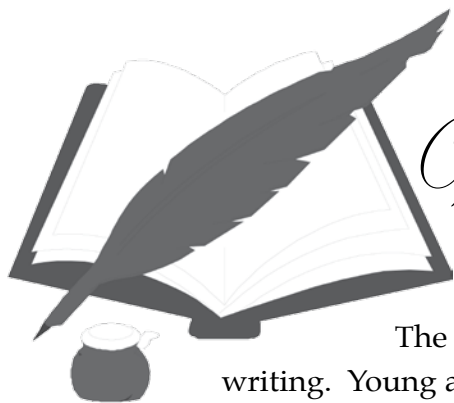

June 15-19

The goal of this week's camp is for participants to learn to enjoy writing. Young authors will practice a variety of styles (poetry, fictional stories, true stories, essays, skits, etc.) under the direction of a combination of local teachers, visiting writers, and college English majors, who will serve more as writing coaches or consultants than as traditional classroom instructors. Emphasis will be placed on generating ideas, choosing a style and audience, ways of composing, and doing necessary revision. Each morning will include an art activity in conjunction with the writing projects.

"Writing for the Fun of It" is open to children ages 8-12.
