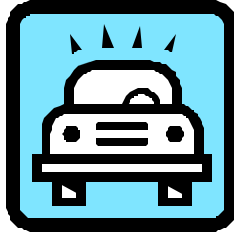


Driver's License Instructions



I. Please, complete attached Non U.S. Citizen Application for a Driver's license.

II. Things you need to have to apply:

1. Proof that you have lived in Murray, KY for 30 days.

We advise:

- If you live off campus—get a letter that was mailed to your Murray address and has been post-marked.
- If you live on campus—get a letter from the housing office. (Make sure that you've registered with the post office on campus, especially the College Courts people.)

2. You must take your original passport and I-94.

3. You must take your *current* I-20. (Make sure the I-20 has the red INS stamp on it.)

4. You must see Mark Galloway or Bill Mckibben.

They will fill out a form stating you are in a specific status category and are 'in-status'.

5. You need to take the form to Kathy Garrison (1st Floor of Sparks Hall). She will have the MSU registrar sign and seal this form.

6. Bring your social security card with you if you have one.

***If you do not have this form or any of the above documents, you will not be able to get a driver's license in Kentucky.**

III. If you have a driver's license from your home country (not an international permit), then you should have the interpreter affidavit completed by someone and then have this form notarized.

IV. Call 270-575-7035 to make an appointment in Paducah. (A direction is attached.)

V. About the paper work.

1. If there is no problem with your paper work, you will be accepted. You will have only 30 days to do the followings.

- Apply for a Driver's License or a Permit—take the Written Test in Murray at the Courthouse on the 4th Street on Tuesdays and Wednesdays in the mornings. For applying for a Permit, you will have to take the Road Test. The date for the Road Test will be assigned to you after you take the Written Test. Please, bring money with you.

2. If there are problems with your paper work, the letter will state you are Denied and state why. At this point, you will contact Mark, Bill, or Kara Short and we will help you.
