

Murray State University/Cooperative Center for Study Abroad Scholarship Application Guidelines

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of financial need as well as academic record and promise that participation will be mutually beneficial to the student and the program. Among the criteria for amounts awarded are: the number of applicants, the apparent financial need in each case, the timeliness and thoroughness of the application, and the total cost of the study abroad program. The awards cannot be given in cash. The amount of the scholarship will be deducted from the recipient's final program payment.

The scholarship applicant should meet the following criteria:

1. Be a full-time student in good academic standing at MSU
2. Have a complete CCSA application turned into the Study Abroad Office by the program deadline date
3. Have an overall grade point average of 3.0 or better
4. Submit a completed scholarship application packet as described below to the MSU Study Abroad Office, 178 Woods Hall, by the application deadline

The application packet will consist of the following:

1. Application form
2. A letter describing financial need of the applicant as well as educational and career objectives and ways in which the CCSA program and the scholarship may help meet those objectives
3. Financial Statement
4. An official transcript issued by the Registrar's Office of work done at MSU delivered in a signed, sealed envelope with the scholarship application
5. Two letters of recommendation from faculty members at Murray State delivered in signed, sealed envelopes with the scholarship application

Information provided by the student is kept completely confidential.

Scholarship Committee decisions are final and confidential.
