Faculty Regent Election

KRS 164.321 Each board of the comprehensive universities shall consist of eight (8) members appointed by the Governor, one (1) member of the teaching faculty, one (1) member of the university non-teaching personnel, and one (1) member of the student body of the respective university or college. The faculty member of a comprehensive university shall be a teaching or research member of the faculty of his or her respective university of the rank of assistant professor or above. The faculty member shall be elected by secret ballot by all faculty members of his or her university of the rank of instructor, assistant professor, or above. The faculty member shall serve for a term of three (3) years and until his successor is elected and qualified. The faculty member shall be eligible for reelection, but he or she shall not be eligible to continue to serve as a member of the board if he or she ceases being a member of the teaching staff of the university. Elections to fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired term in the same manner as provided for the original election.

Those faculty members of the rank of instructor, assistant professor, associate professor, or professor will vote May 9-10, 2022, for the faculty regent on the Murray State University Board of Regents. The term of office will run July 01, 2022 through June 30, 2025.

Balloting will be conducted via myGate. Voting will open at 12:00 a.m. on May 9, 2022, and close at 11:59 p.m. on May 10, 2022. If you have problems in casting a ballot, or if you believe you are eligible to vote and are unable to cast a ballot, please check with Faculty Senate Rules, Elections and Bylaws Committee via email at msu.facultysenate@murraystate.edu.

Results will be released by May 13, 2022 after candidates have been contacted. In the event of a runoff, a new ballot will be posted to myGate with the top two candidates from the initial election and voting will occur the 3rd full week of May following the same procedure.
