9/7/12	BoR 2.28 & 5.3	Addition of a Policy on Weapons and Dangerous Materials (2.28) and corresponding edits to Section 5.3 (11) - Code of Conduct.		
3/1/12	BoR 2.1 & 6.6	Addition of duties to President's job description and the University Assessment Committee to Standing Committee structure		
8/26/11	BoR 1.1, 5.3, 5.7 & 6.6	Clarification and strengthening of the judicial process, appeal process, and student code of conduct. Changes were also made to the membership of the Campus Safety and International Studies advisory committees.		
5/20/11	BoR 3.8.2	Added a Personal Bicycle Loan Program that mirrors the current policy for personal computers.		
5/20/11	BoR 4.6	Faculty Senate proposed changes to the qualifications of "instructors".		
5/20/11	BoR 6.5 & 6.9	SGA voted to increase GPA requirements for all senators and officers as well as establish two (2) seats on SGA for the School of Nursing.		
2/25/11	BoR 3.5	Language added permitting the President to implement policies and procedures with appropriate consequence to ensure compliance with leave reporting.		
12/10/10	BoR 6.6	Changes to both BoR 6.6 and the Faculty Handbook Section 1.5 were made to increase alignment of the standing and advisory committee sections.		
9/17/10	BoR 1.1	Eliminated the twelve (12) current Committees of the Board and added seven (7) new Committees which more accurately reflect the responsibilities of the Board		
12/4/09	BoR 2.27	Edited the email communication policy to outline areas in which email would not be used		
9/25/09	BoR 2.27	Added e-mail as an official form of communication to Board of Regents Policy.
