### MURRAY STATE UNIVERSITY ENDOWMENT MATCH PROGRAM 2021-2022 Summary Report

This report summarizes the programmatic and financial results of the Endowment Match Program at Murray State University during Fiscal Year 2021-22.

Murray State has received all of its state matching funds. It has also received all its private matching funds as of June 30, 2014. Since the inception of the program in 1998, Murray State has received \$10,070,787 in state matching funds and \$10,070,787 in private matching funds for a total endowment increase of \$20,141,574.

### **Endowment activity**

With these endowment funds, the University has been able to establish two endowed chairs and five endowed professorships. Both chairs and three of the professorships were filled during the reporting period. All endowed chairs and two professorships reported expenditure activity during the fiscal year.

In addition to the chairs and professorships, the university has been able to create 29 endowed scholarships and 5 mission support endowments. Twenty-eight of the 29 endowed scholarships reported expenditure activity during the year. In addition, two of the five mission support endowments had expenditures in the reporting period. ### **Demographic Information**

Program recipients consist of four males and three females (Table 2). One chair, one chair staff and the three occupied professorship occupants are non-Hispanic whites and one chair staff occupant is unknown (Table 3).

The relatively small number of awards given to minority recipients from these scholarship endowments likely resulted from the availability of two other scholarship funds devoted to minority students. Scholarships amounts from those other funds sources equaled \$705,570 and were awarded to 34 males of the following ethnicity; 21 Black, 6 Hispanic, and 7 Other; and to 80 females of the following ethnicity; 57 Black, 7 Hispanic, and 16 Other for a total of 114 awards during 2021-22.

### Sources of Funds, Earnings and Expenditures

Since all available State endowment program funds were matched in 2010-11, Tables 5 and 6 remain unchanged from the prior reports and, therefore, are not included.

As of June 30, 2022, the total market value of the 41 endowment accounts established under the Endowment Matching Program was \$26,826,310 Table 7, (Page 5). Total state funds received for the Bucks for Brains endowment program since its inception during the 1998-00 biennium equal \$10,024,525. With the further addition of the \$46,262 for the two capital projects, the total state matching funds received increases to \$10,070,787. All private matching gifts have been received, as of 2013-14. Therefore, total funds received for the Bucks for Brains endowments equal \$20,141,574. Total expenditures for endowment operations for 2021-22 equaled \$792,386. Investment earnings equaled \$1,262,249.
