The goal of this grant is to provide professional development, resources, and mentoring support to first-year teachers who were graduates of Murray State University. Grant coordinators, Donna Wear and Amy Waggoner developed a strong program for the participants at their first meeting held on April 18th.

The program included guest speakers and break-out sessions led by veterans in the field. The grant funds also allowed participants to leave with a variety of classroom resources, a classroom crisis bag, and receive a stipend to go towards their classrooms.
