KENTUCKY*	\$9,252	The following counties qualify for in-state tuition: Massac County in Illinois, Posey, Vanderburgh and Warrick Counties in Indiana, and Henry, Montgomery, Obion, Stewart and Weakley Counties in Tennessee. Regional states include Alabama, Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Missouri and Mississippi. Tuition rates are based on 12-15 hours per semester (full-time). To be eligible for regional tuition, freshmen and sophomores must live on campus and purchase a meal plan.

*Any hours above 15 will be additional charge per credit hour

Billing & Holds

- Fall Semester Due August 5h
- Spring Semester Due January 5th
- 3 month and 4 month Installment Plans available (\$30 fee)
- Outstanding balance = Scheduling Hold
- Common question from students is about the Transcript hold. A Transcript hold will not prevent a student from scheduling. All students will have a transcript hold if they owe a balance.

Swapping Courses

- If you have a student that needs to drop a course and add another course, please ensure that this is completed on the same day to minimize tuition adjustments for the students.
- We always advise that the student add the course first to ensure they do not need any overrides, and then drop their other course on the same day.
- Students could still be responsible for course fees associated with the classes that they are swapping depending on the proration of charges percentage.

Proration of Charges

• Proration of charges are based on the different parts of term. So students that are in multiple parts of term, will have different proration percentages.

Bookstore Charges

- Students are allowed to charge books and needed supplies to their student account up until the 6th day of the beginning of the semester.
- This is always the day after the "last" day to drop or add a full semester course.

Scholarships

- Students should complete a general scholarship application each year.
- Please encourage students to check their myGate and review their scholarships and their financial aid package.
- We have many students that simply do not accept their scholarships. We email and text, but they still go unaccepted and they are enrolled students.

Academic Achievement Scholarship Renewal

- Must complete at least 24 credit hours between Fall and Spring
- Cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Student is notified if requirements are not met
 - -Appeals are available.

Financial Aid

Financial Aid

- Students must complete FAFSA Application each year Opens October 1st
- Satisfy any outstanding requirements showing on mygate
- Student must be degree-seeking
- Courses must count towards students degree

Concurrent Enrollment Form: Allows student to receive financial aid for course(s) student is taking at another school

Summer Financial Aid

- No additional application required
- Once student is enrolled, we will automatically review eligibility and award financial aid
- Summer Financial Aid is limited
- Undergraduate = minimum of 6 credit hours
- Graduate= minimum of 3 credit hours

Federal Financial Aid: Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

- 1. Complete at least 67% of attempted courses
- 2. GPA- Good standing with Registrar
- 3. Obtain degree within 150% of required hours

If not met, student will not be eligible for federal aid.

- *SAP Appeal available on myGate
- *Academic Advisors may be asked to sign Academic Plan Form

Federal Financial Aid:

Dropping or Audit Course

If student is considering dropping/auditing course, please advise them to speak with Financial Aid Counselor.

Withdrawing From All Courses

Federal Financial Aid may have to be returned.

Federal Work Study

- Student must indicate he/she is interested in work study on the FAFSA.
- If eligible (need-based), student job on campus to earn paycheck.
- MSU Student Employment positions also available.
