Sample Timeline

Fall Semester, year 1:

ECO 331: Intermediate Microeconomics (Fall only) ECO 231 and calculus are pre-requisites

2 classes towards minor*

Spring Semester, year 2:

ECO 330: Intermediate Macroeconomics (Spring only) ECO 230 and calculus are pre-requisites

ECO 305: Money and Banking. ECO 230 and 231 are pre-requisites

ECO elective*

2 Courses towards minor*

Fall Semester, year 2:

ECO 460: International Economics (Fall only): ECO 231 is pre-requisite

ECO 498: Research Methods in Economics (Fall only): Senior Standing is pre-requisite

Spring Semester, year 2:

ECO 499: Senior Seminar in Economics: ECO 498 is pre-requisite

Two courses towards minor*

-*These courses are added as a guide, electives and courses for the minor may be taken at anytime with advisor consent.

- The major accounts for 27 of the required 42 upper level electives.

- Students need 120 total hours, with a minimum GPA, overall and in the major and minor, of 2.0 to graduate from Murray State. In addition 40 hours of course work must be taken at Murray State.
