- a. ENG 101, 102, 104 or 105, or HON 150
- b. MAT 117 (or higher level math)
- c. COM 161 or HON 165
- d. LIB 600

If the student does not have these requirements, the student must complete the requirements between the first and second year of graduate work. Courses may be taken at the local community college.
