Master of Arts in Postsecondary Education Administration

The program is designed for emerging leaders in higher education and student affairs at postsecondary institutions including community colleges, four-year public, and four-year private colleges and universities. Three (3) hours of supervised internship experience in a postsecondary education administration setting are required. The completion of either a capstone research project or case study analysis serves as the exit requirement for the program. The curriculum provides students with a foundation for research, administration, leadership, student development theory, multiculturalism and diversity issues, group/team dynamics, and legal/ethic issues.
