Purpose:

The MSU Center for Communication Disorders (CDI)'s Speech-Language Pathology Program is undergoing an accreditation process. A public meeting will be held during the scheduled site visit to allow the public to provide input about the program. Comments can be submitted publicly during the meeting, or in written format prior to the meeting.

How to Submit Comments:

All comments are due in the Accreditation Office no later than 15 days before the first day of the scheduled site visit. Comments received after this time will not be considered. Comments may be submitted by email (accreditation@asha.org), fax (301-296-8570), or mailed to Accreditation Public Comment, Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (CAA), 2200 Research Boulevard, #310, Rockville, MD 20850.

All Comments Must:

- Relate to a program's compliance with the current Standards for Accreditation
- Identify the specific program seeking accreditation with the CAA
- If written, include the commenter's name, address and telephone contact information, commenter's relationship to the program, and signature.

Comments that do not meet these requirements will not be considered, and the individual or group commenting will be notified.
