

IHSA Team Cost Estimates

Costs are incurred during the academic school year, not the calendar year.

Item	Cost
National Dues	\$45 one team, \$65 two teams (must be paid by credit card)
Local dues (Horseman's Assoc.)	\$35
Sponsorship	\$300 (Can be covered by selling ads for home shows.)
Class required for each semester on a per team basis (2 semesters per academic year)	
Zero credit	\$87 paid by voucher at the University Bookstore
1 Hour Credit	\$72 lab fee
Entry Fees, set by host schools	\$45 - \$55/ class Students will typically show in 1 or 2 classes per show. There are usually 4 weekends per academic year or 8 shows. Riders who move on to regional/semi-finals/zones/nationals may be able to get some of the expenses covered
Motel (booked by coach)	\$90 – \$120 per weekend Students split the cost of hotel equally. There is usually travel to 3 or 4 shows per academic year.
Meals:	
Breakfast - usually covered by hotel	
Lunch cooler	\$10 - \$12
Dinner - varies, go as a group, cost responsibility of rider	

Purchase and maintenance of show clothes are the responsibility of the rider.
