

Driver's License Instructions

Please, complete attached Non U.S. Citizen Application for a Driver's License.

I. Things you need to have to apply:

1. Proof that you have lived in Murray, KY.

We advise:

- If you live off campus—get a letter that was mailed to your Murray address and has been post-marked. Proof of address cannot be no more than 30 days old.
 - If you live on campus—get a letter from the housing office. (Make sure that you've registered with the post office on campus, especially the College Courts people.)
2. You must take your original passport and copy of I-94.
 3. You must take your *all* I-20s or DS-2019. (Make sure you have the I-20 or DS-2019 that has the red/blue INS stamp on it.)
 4. You must see your **International Student Advisor**.

They will fill out a form stating you are in a specific status category and are 'in-status'.

5. Bring your social security card or ineligibility letter that you received from Social Security Office.

***If you do not have any of the above documents, you will not be able to get a driver's license in Kentucky.**

- ### II. If you have a driver's license from your home country (not an international permit), then you should have the interpreter affidavit completed by someone and then have this form notarized.

III. About the paper work.

1. If there is no problem with your paper work, you will be accepted. You will have only 30 days to do the followings.
 - Apply for a Driver's License or a Permit—take the Written Test in Murray at the Courthouse on the 4th Street on Tuesdays and Wednesdays in the mornings. For applying for a Permit, you will have to take the Road Test. The date for the Road Test will be assigned to you after you take the Written Test. Please, bring money with you.
2. If there are problems with your paper work, the letter will state you are Denied and state why. At this point, you will contact Madison, Misty, Dominique, or Marcus we will help you.

DO NOT GO TO DRIVERS LICENSE OFFICE ON WEDNESDAY THEY ARE NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC!!!

Office Hours for Drivers License: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8am to 3pm!

Starting August 2019 a \$30 application fee will be changed when you turn in your driver's license application

- Applicant must also present the following “original” documentation: (a) Social Security Card or Ineligibility Letter from the Social Security Office; (b) Official proof of residency (proof of address within last 30 days), i.e., utility bill, lease agreement, bank statement, credit card statement or postmarked envelope.
- Exchange visitors (J1) must have a DS2019.
- Individuals or dependents on any work status (L1, L2, H1B, H4, etc.) must present a current paycheck stub or letter from employer verifying current employment within the last 30 days.
- Students who are an F1 status will need to present their I-20 and proof of enrollment (within the last 30 days) from the college or university.
