TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE

Associate in Arts in Psychology to Murray State University's Bachelor of Arts or Science in Psychology

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for Associate in Arts in Psychology at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Arts or Science in Psychology at Murray State University.

Admission Requirements

Murray State University admission requirements for domestic first-time transfer students can be found online here.

Degree Requirements

At least 42 semester hours of the 120 hours required for a baccalaureate degree must be earned in courses at the 300-level or above (upper-level courses). Transfer courses at the 100- or 200-level that are direct equivalents of upper-level Murray State courses will be considered upper-level credit. Transfer courses at the 100- or 200-level that may be substituted for upper-level Murray State courses or requirements will not be considered upper-level credit.

The baccalaureate degree candidate must have a GPA of at least 2.00: (1) in all credits presented for graduation whether earned at Murray State or elsewhere (cumulative GPA); (2) in all credits completed at Murray State; and (3) in the courses for each major, minor or area.
