TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE

FOR

Associate in Science to Murray State University's Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science/Exercise Physiology Track

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science/Exercise Physiology Track at Murray State University.

Admission Requirements

Murray State University admission requirements for domestic first-time transfer students can be found online. Current link is available here.

Students must earn a minimum *C* in all EXS courses included as prerequisites and core as well as a cumulative GPA of 2.75 for students pursuing the exercise physiology track.

Degree Requirements

At least 42 semester hours of the 120 hours required for a baccalaureate degree must be earned in courses at the 300-level or above (upper-level courses). Transfer courses at the 100 or 200-level that are direct equivalents of upper-level Murray State courses will be considered upper-level credit. Transfer courses at the 100 or 200-level that may be substituted for upper-level Murray State courses or requirements will not be considered upper-level credit.

The baccalaureate degree candidate must have a GPA of at least 2.50: (1) in all credits presented for graduation whether earned at Murray State or elsewhere (cumulative GPA); (2) in all credits completed at Murray State; and (3) in the courses for each major, minor or area.

A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 is required to graduate from this program.

Prior to graduating with an exercise science degree, all EXS students are required to take a comprehensive exam over material covered in core EXS classes. Students must earn at least 75% on the exam to graduate with an EXS degree. The exam is offered on select dates and is taken by students enrolled in EXS 445 Senior Seminar I.
