## AAS in Business Administration – HUMAN RESOURCES Management Track to BSB - AREA IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION at Murray State University

### **Overview**

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for Associate in Applied Science Business Administration Human Resources Management Track at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science in Business in Business Administration at Murray State University.

### **Murray State University Admission Requirements**

### **Admission to Business Administration Program:**

Programmatic admission is required to any of the AACSB accredited business programs. Students may transfer to Murray State at any point along this pathway, but they may not be accepted to the Business Administration program, and therefore permitted to enroll in upper division courses, until they complete all prerequisite coursework, as noted below.

### **General Transfer Requirements**

Students can complete the transfer application online at [www.murraystate.edu/apply](http://www.murraystate.edu/apply). Transfer requirements, scholarship information, and other relevant transfer information can also be found at [www.murraystate.edu/admissions/transfer](http://www.murraystate.edu/admissions/transfer).

The general University Scholarship application is due at or before February 5<sup>th</sup> before the Fall semester entry. All students must complete the FAFSA to be eligible for scholarships.

### **Degree Requirements**

General Education Transfer must be complete and reflected on Murray State RACR Degree Audit. Student must have a minimum of 42 Upper Level Credit Hours and at least 120 credit hours overall to graduate from Murray State University.

The baccalaureate degree candidate must have a GPA of at least 2.00: (1) in all credits presented for graduation whether earned at Murray State or elsewhere (cumulative GPA); (2) in all credits completed at Murray State; and (3) in the courses for each major, minor or area.
