

Resolution 27-16-R1: Resolution to Support Restrictions Pertaining to the Scheduling of Philanthropic Events

Purpose: For the College Panhellenic Council of Murray State University to support restrictions pertaining to the scheduling of philanthropic events.

Whereas it is challenging for Panhellenic chapters to participate in multiple events at a time;

Whereas the National Panhellenic Manual of Information states "The individual chapters should understand that a College Panhellenic works together to promote and facilitate educational programs, fundraising efforts, philanthropic endeavors and the recruitment process. Working together promotes positive competition and builds healthy relationships within the Panhellenic community;"

Whereas the National Panhellenic Creed states "Cooperation for furthering fraternity life, in harmony with its best possibilities, is the ideal that shall guide our fraternity activities;"

Whereas it is vital that sorority chapters continue to support all philanthropic events in order to further fraternity life;

Whereas sorority chapters enjoy participating in philanthropic events and giving back to the community; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the College Panhellenic Council of Murray State University:

- 1. NPC and IFC member groups will limit philanthropic events from overlapping each other on any given day, and
- 2. NPC and IFC member groups will limit their "philanthropic week" to include a total of no more than 4 events (main philanthropic event, rebate night, etc.), and
- 3. NPC and IFC member groups will limit "change wars" to partake only during that "philanthropic week" with no limit to days or times for the week, and
- 4. IFC member groups will not have a registered social event at a time which conflicts with a NPC members groups main philanthropic event.
