## RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR ADDITIONAL STUDENT PARKING AT THE CURRIS CENTER

Passed: 38-0

Date: October 20, 2021

WHEREAS: The Curris Center was built on the idea that it would serve as a student center

WHEREAS: In recent years, visitor parking has gradually increased while student, faculty, and staff

parking has decreased

WHEREAS: Prospective students and their families will have ample parking space with the 30 visitor

spots to be left on the front row of the front lot of the Curris Center

WHEREAS: The Curris Center lot will continue to be reserved for Racer Days, Admitted Student

Weekends, Racer Nation Orientations, and other campus-wide recruitment events

WHEREAS: Dining Services is primarily for students, and the renewed parking lot will open Dining

Services to more students at Murray State

WHEREAS: The Student Government Association is dedicated to advocating for 69 additional parking

spots in the front Curris Center lot to be used primarily for students, and also faculty and

staff who cannot find parking spots behind the Curris Center

## LET IT BE RESOLVED:

Murray State University's Student Government Association supports renewing the layout of the front lot of the Curris Center. The new layout shall be as follows:

- 30 Visitor Parking Spaces on the front row of the building, 5 of which will be located in the loop to be used for express parking for Dining Services.
- 119 Red/Blue Parking Spaces for the remainder of the front lot of the Curris Center, all of which are to be used by students, faculty, and staff.
