

Bill 81-17-B3: Bill to Require the SGA Senate to Say the Pledge of Allegiance

PURPOSE: To require the SGA Senate to recite the Pledge of Allegiance at the start

of every meeting.

WHEREAS: Any governing body for a public institution should pledge their

allegiance to the country that gives and protects their liberty to

convene, and

WHEREAS: Many people on our campus have either served or will be serving in the

United States Armed Forces. We should respect them and what they, and

many others, have fought for.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Senate of the Student Government

Association of Murray State University shall recite the Pledge of Allegiance at the beginning of every session it convenes. There shall always be an American flag present at the Senate meetings. The President may either lead the Pledge of Allegiance or may invite another student or

guest to do so.
