RESOLUTION ADVOCATING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MURRAY STATE COLLEGE OF VETRINARY MEDICINE

DATE: January 29th, 2025

WHEREAS: Murray State University seeks to establish a College of Veterinary

Medicine to address the critical need for veterinarians in Kentucky, enhancing animal health and supporting the state's agricultural sector;

and

WHEREAS: KRS 164.295 currently prohibits Murray State University from moving

forward with this proposed doctorate, addressing pressing needs within

the Commonwealth of Kentucky; and

WHEREAS: this initiative aligns with Kentucky's strategic goals of enhancing

education, healthcare, and economic development, addressing pressing

needs within the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS: the establishment of a College of Veterinary Medicine at Murray State

University would provide increased educational opportunities for students, improve veterinary services, and strengthen the agricultural

industry within the Commonwealth; therefore

LET IT BE RESOLVED: That the Student Government Association of Murray State

University advocates for the support and implementation of this initiative, through the amendment of KRS 164.295, recognizing its potential to significantly benefit the citizens of Kentucky; and

State University administration, the Kentucky Council on

Postsecondary Education, and state legislative leaders to express unified
